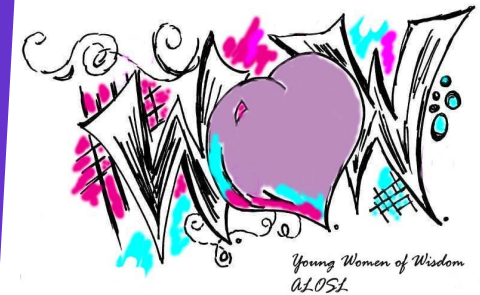
ALOSL, Inc. is the umbrella for many components of women's marketplace ministry.
